Area food pantries often experience high needs for these items: baked beans, pork and beans, canned fruit, tuna, chicken, canned vegetables, cereal, oatmeal, granola and breakfast bars, juice, mac and cheese, hamburger and tuna helper, pancake mix, syrup, pasta, spaghetti, pasta sauce, peanut butter, jelly, rice side dishes, soups and chili, and household and personal items, such as body wash and soap, dish soap, laundry detergent, shampoo and conditioner, toilet paper, toothpaste and toothbrushes.
